Nine members of the GSMS attended the Northeast Woodcarvers Round Up and participated in a number of workshops over the 4 days.







The Forest Resource Education Center (FREC) first opened under the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Parks and Forestry in 1982 as the NJ Tree Nursery. The NJ Tree Nursery grows 300,000 seedlings yearly for reforestation across New Jersey. In 1995, the FREC offered their first interpretive program, "Seeds to Trees". The Seeds to Trees program engages students in the work and care it takes to grow a seed into a tree and is still offered today along with 11 other interpretive programs.

In 1995, the FREC also hosted the first Fall Forestry Festival. Popular with families and scouts, the festival became a yearly event.

In 2003, a new interpretive center was completed. The exhibit area of the interpretive center features sections on forest succession, wildlife, tree seeds, forestry tools, forest fire, and pruning.

The FREC staff teaches over 10,000 people each year about the benefits of forests and trees. Groups of ten or more can schedule a free interpretive program during regular hours—Monday-Friday, from 9am-2pm.

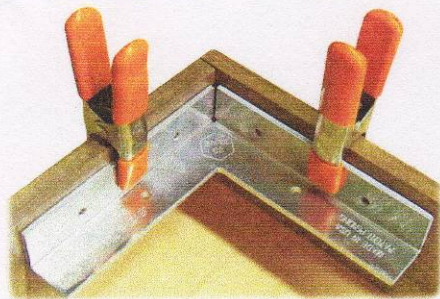
